

Elizabeth Violet Hill nee` Mattingly (1893 -1955)

Elizabeth Violet Was born on the 25th August 1896. She was to be the last of 9 children that Richard and Elizabeth Mattingly were to have. Her mother was 45 at the time and is shown in 1891 as running a restaurant next to Greenwich Park Station. She is later recorded as being born in Lewisham, which is where they may have been living as it is close by. In the 1901 Census she is aged 7 and living with her parents at Kennington in London. The following Census in 1911 shows her living with her father at Beechcroft, near Hattingley in Hampshire. Her mother is running a boarding house at 65 Ferndale Road in Stockwell, London at the same time. In 1917 she marries Peter Hill and moves near her mother at 120 Ferndale Road. Her sister Florence and brother in law Adolphe Chevalier are witnesses to the wedding. Her husband is shown to be serving in the British Expeditionary Forced in France at the time. They are to have here children - Violet born in 1919, Margaret born in 1921? and a son, Peter John Hill in 1923. In 1927 they are living at no. 72 Sandmere Road and in 1938 move down the street to no. 39, where her sister, Mary Masey was living. The 1939 Census describes Peter, aged 58 as a Hotel Waiter and their son, Peter John, aged 16, as a Stationery Manufacturer. The Electoral register for 1951 has them living with her sister, Rose Grimble and husband, Charles at 156 Cavendish Road, Clapham. Elizabeth is shown to have died in 1955. Peter Hill died in 1966, Violet dies in 1962 , aged 42 at 9 Hartswood House, Christchurch Road, Brixton, SW2 their son, Peter died in 1980, aged 55 at Havering in Essex. All three children never married and spent most of their lives together. Margaret was to live the longest dying at Westgate, near Margate in Kent in?

The 1911 Census shows Richard Mattingly (Senior) aged 65 living at Beech Croft, Medstead, Alton in Hampshire with his two daughters Ellen (aged 24) and Violet (aged 17). He is described as married for 42 years with 9 living children.

His daughter is shown as living at 120 Ferndale Road in Brixton at the time, which was where her mother was. It is interesting to see her sister Florence and brother in law Adolphe Chevalier signing it as witnesses. Her husband was serving in the British Expeditionary Forces in France at the time.

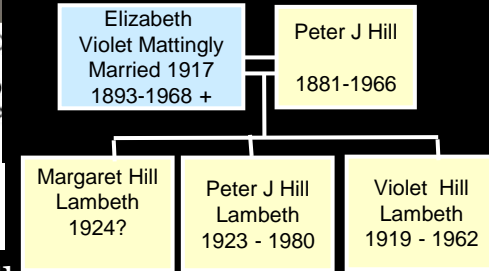

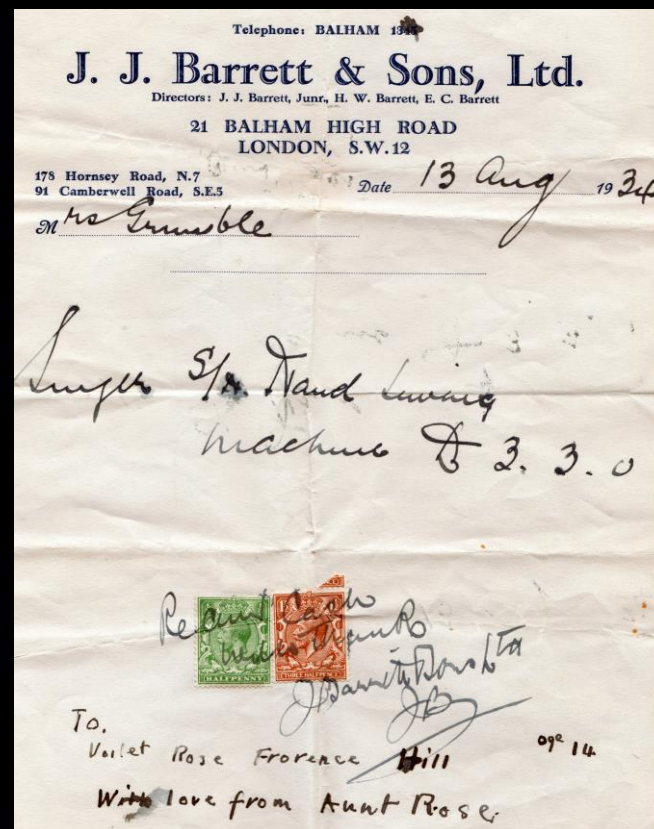
Violet (Betty) 1920-1962, Margaret Mary, John (Peter) taken in February 1942.

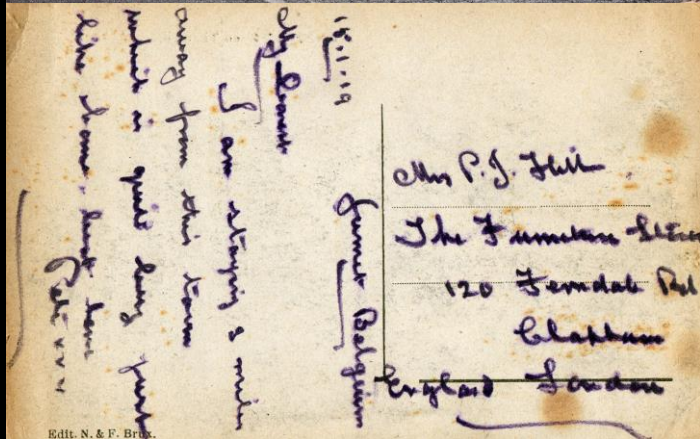
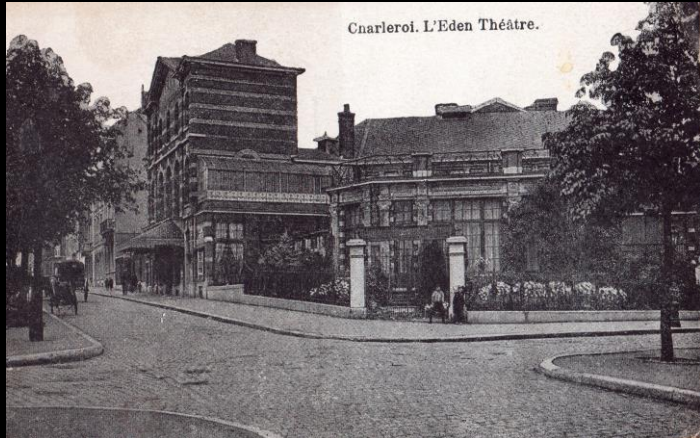
