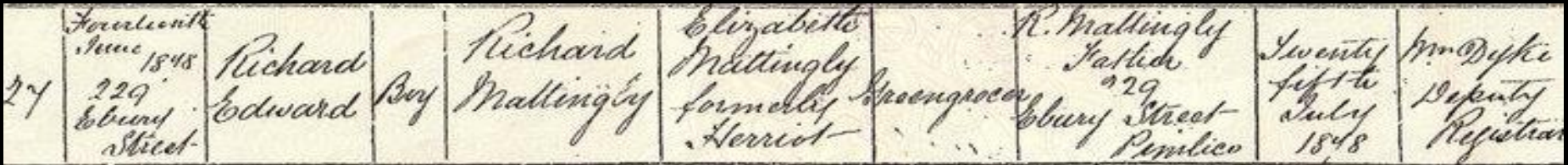

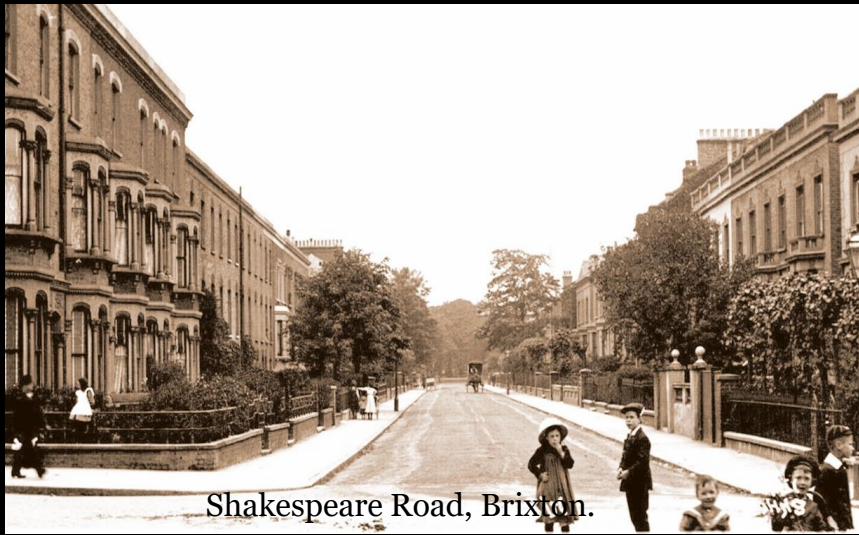

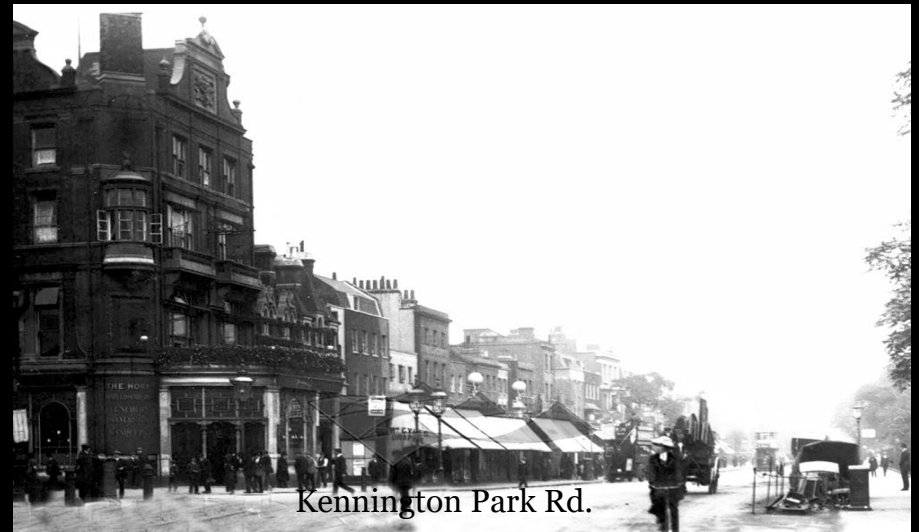

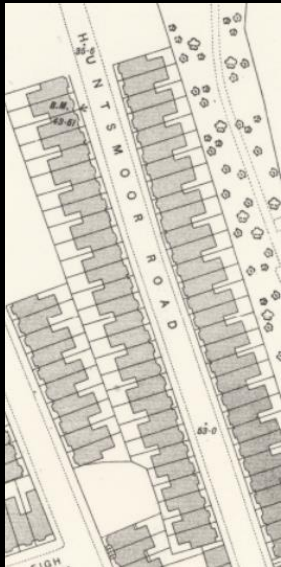

Huntsmoor Road in Wandsworth is shown here at the bottom of this early map. The Street was bombed on 16<sup>th</sup> April 1941 when a land mine dropped and demolished all the houses. It no longer exists and Bartholomew Close, part of the East Hill Estate has been built on the former site as shown below.

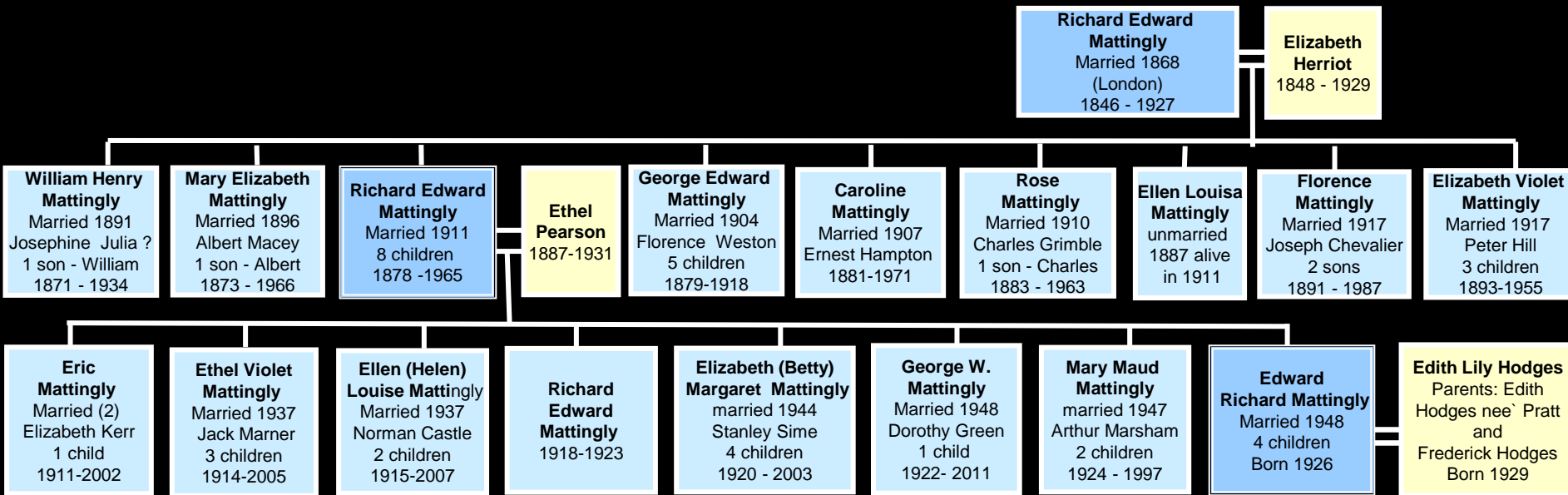

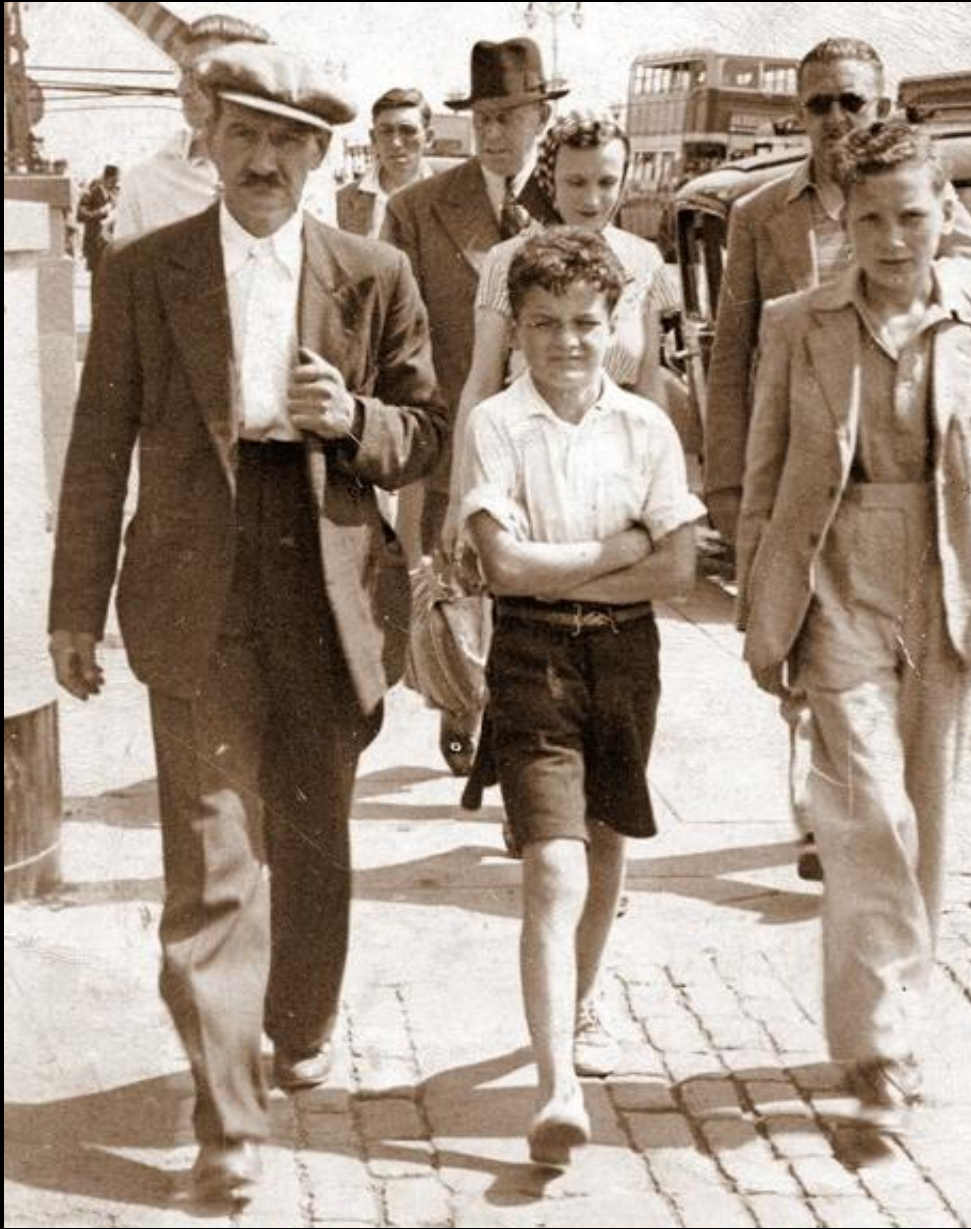

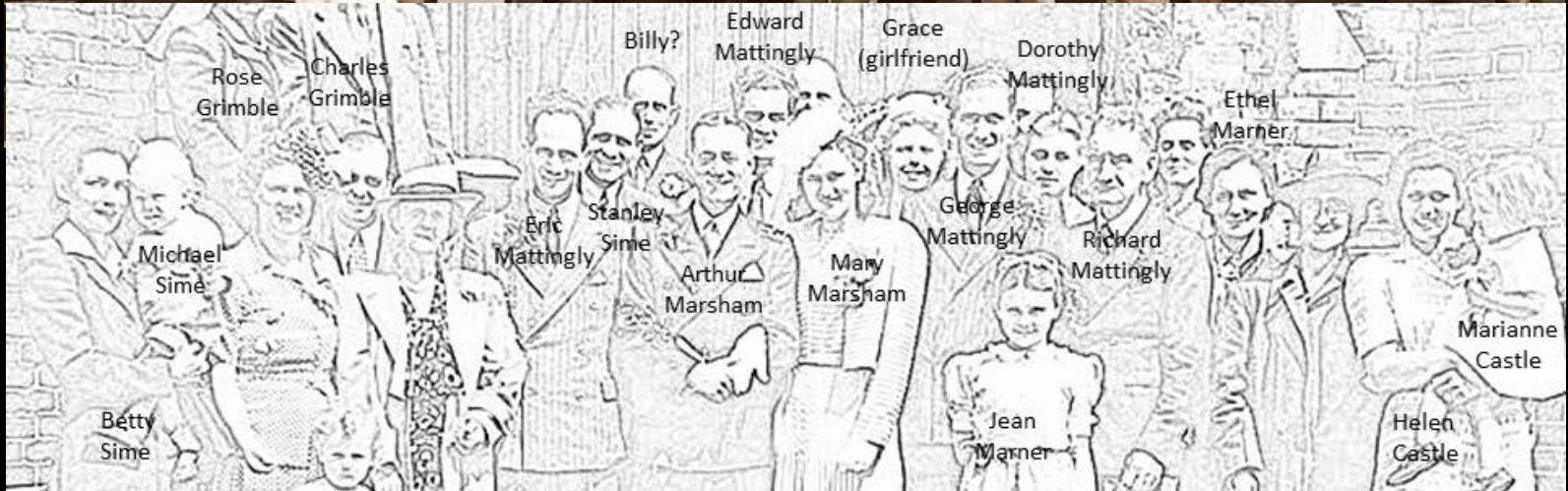

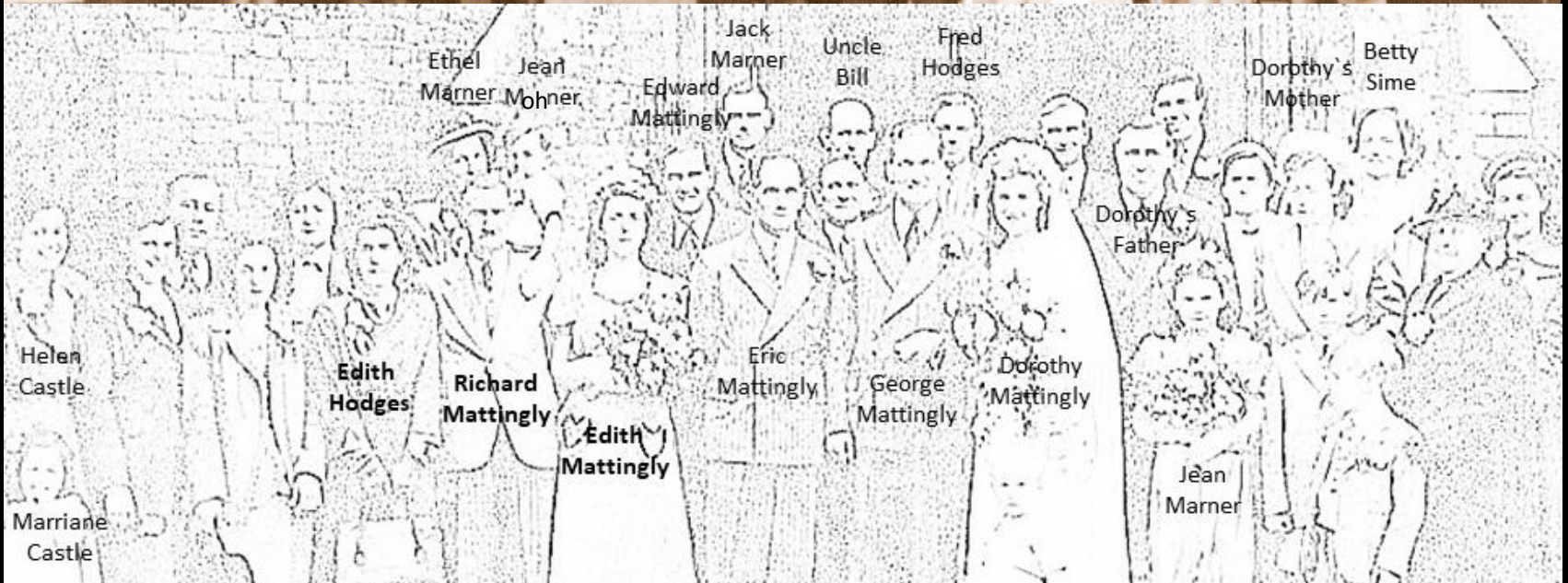
