


William Henry Mattingly (1836-1915)



William had spent most of his working life in St. Johns Wood, Hampstead. Initially at 43 Boundary Road and finally at 2 Alexandra mews just off this road as a Coachman. Although he married twice he was not blessed with children. It is interesting to see that his brother, Richard, named one of his children, William Henry Mattingly after him.

The 1901 Census reveals that he has retired to 29 Standen Road in Tunbridge Wells with his wife Emma. A decade later and they are again seen there and remain until his death in 1915, aged 79. Emma was to die five years later, aged 83.
